

Safety Policy Statement

- Palmerston North Airport Limited (PNAL) has a Zero Harm approach to those who visit and work within our airport community.
- We will encourage habits of wellness, increase awareness of factors and resources contributing to wellbeing and inspire individuals to take responsibility for their own health, and the health of team members, within the PNAL team and the wider airport community.
- We have a Just culture, one where all members of our airport community have a duty of care towards one another, and are actively encouraged and empowered to speak up on safety related concerns.
- Compliance with all standards and regulations including the Health and Safety at Work Act (2015), and PNALs Safety Management System, is a core responsibility of everyone who works within our airport community including the PNAL Board, Chief Executive, management, team members, and contractors.
- Third parties are also members of our airport community and we will work cooperatively with them to ensure our respective safety objectives are met.
- We will monitor our performance against safety targets and objectives and fully review all safety-related incidents ensuring that we continue to learn and improve our Safety Management System.
- We will ensure appropriate resourcing and team training is provided to enable the achievement of this policy and our Zero Harm objective.
